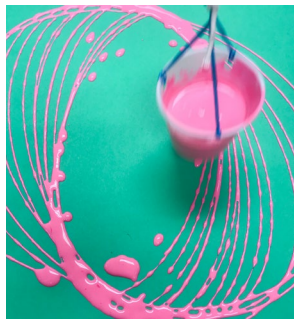


The supplies needed for Projects 21-24 are listed below.

Creative substitutions are welcome and exact sizes and quantities are somewhat flexible. These lists and photos are just to get you thinking about what you've already got and what you might want to gather for the upcoming activities.



## PENDULUM FLOW

- Paint** (Watered-down Tempera)
- Paper** (Several large sheets, 12x18 or bigger. Consider newspaper or the white side of inexpensive wrapping paper.)
- Two Chairs and a Broomstick** (Preferably matching chairs for even height)
- String** (at least 3 feet, craft string or similar)
- Disposable Cup or Plastic Water Bottle** (We'll discuss several alternatives.)
- Hole Puncher**
- Hammer and Nail**
- Scissors**
- Tape**

## PAPER PULP

- Construction Paper** (Colors flexible)
- Water**
- School Glue**
- Two Shallow Trays or Casserole Dishes**
- Tempera or Acrylic Paint** (Optional)

## BALLOON STAMPING

- A Small Inflated Balloon**
- Tempera Paint** (3-4 colors)
- Paper** (Size, color, and weight are all flexible.)
- A Large Plate or Tray for Paint** (A small plate per color could work, if preferred.)

## TAPE & STICKERS

- Tape** (Masking, duct, washi, electrical, and/or painter's tape are all great options.)
- Stickers** (Blank label-type stickers are nice for little fingers)
- Large Plastic Tray** (Plastic serving trays from the dollar are perfect!)
- Scissors**
