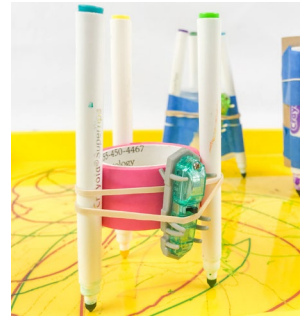
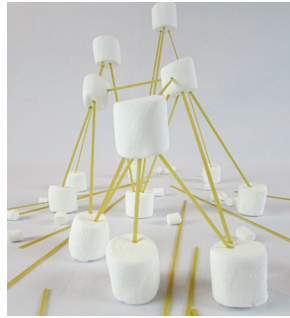


The supplies needed for Projects 25-28 are listed below.

Creative substitutions are welcome and exact sizes and quantities are somewhat flexible. These lists and photos are just to get you thinking about what you've already got and what you might want to gather for the upcoming activities.



## FIZZY PAINT

- ❑ **Baking Soda** (at least 1 cup)
- ❑ **Vinegar** (at least 4oz)
- ❑ **Watercolor Paper** (or other heavy/thick paper)
- ❑ **Kool-Aid Powdered Drink Mix** (This is for color and acidity. Provide a few different packets for color variety. Other brands can be substituted as long as they have citric acid as an ingredient.)
- ❑ **Spray bottle or dropper/pipette**

## MARSHMALLOWS & LINGUINE

- ❑ **Marshmallows** (Jumbo, regular, or mini sizes are fine)
- ❑ **Uncooked Linguine Pasta Noodles** (1/3 of an uncooked box per artist should be plenty. Spaghetti, fettucine, and angel hair could be substituted, but linguine has an ideal thickness for this.)

## ROLLER PRINTING

- ❑ **A Rolling Pin** (Kids craft rolling pins are available online or you can get creative with a small foam paint roller)
- ❑ **Paper** (any weight, any color, sized just needs to be at least as wide as your roller)
- ❑ **Tempera or Acrylic Paint**
- ❑ **Paint Brush or Sponge Brush**
- ❑ **Textures to Wrap Around the Roller** (suggestions: rubber bands, bubble wrap, yarn, netting, adhesive craft foam)
- ❑ **Hot Glue**

## SCRIBBLE BOT

- ❑ **Markers** (Washable recommended, any size, varied colors)
- ❑ **Paper** (Or you can scribble directly on a tray or box lid)
- ❑ **Hexbug® or Old Electric Toothbrush** (or something that has a vibrating motor, needs working battery)
- ❑ **Tray or Box Lid** (To contain the wiggling bots!)
- ❑ **Tape or Rubber Bands**
- ❑ **Cup** (Anything light and cylindrical could be substituted.)
