

The supplies needed for Projects 37-40 are listed below.

Creative substitutions are welcome and exact sizes and quantities are somewhat flexible. These lists and photos are just to get you thinking about what you've already got and what you might want to gather for the upcoming activities.



SPRAY PAINTING

- ❑ **Tempera Paint** (watered down)
- ❑ **Things that "Spray"** (water guns/pool toy shooters, all-purpose spray bottles, hoses, fine mist water bottles)
- ❑ **Things to Spray On** (an upright canvas, a fence, a shower wall, or craft roll paper taped to a vertical surface, like large box or portable table on its side)
 - *The white side of inexpensive wrapping paper can be substituted for craft paper*
 - *As pictured above, a horizontal surface can work, too! Just secure paper flat on the ground with some rocks.*

CRAFT STICK PLAY

- ❑ **Craft Sticks**
- ❑ **Glue** (school glue or low temp hot glue)
- ❑ **Cardboard Flat** (optional, to serve as a base)
- ❑ **Paint or Markers** (optional, to embellish design)

HOLE PUNCHING

- ❑ **Hole Puncher**
- ❑ **Construction Paper** (multiple colors cut into 1" strips, 1 larger sheet for base)
- ❑ **School Glue**
- ❑ **Shallow Tray** (optional, to contain the punched pieces)

BAR SOAP PRINTING

- ❑ **Bar Soap** (Ivory® Bar Soap has an ideal block-like shape)
- ❑ **A Craft Stick** (to gently scrape down any logos or soap designs)
- ❑ **Cardstock Paper**
- ❑ **A Carving Tool** (we recommend a straight vegetable peeler or a flathead screwdriver)
- ❑ **Tempera Paint** (or block printing ink)
- ❑ **Sponge or Sponge Brush**
