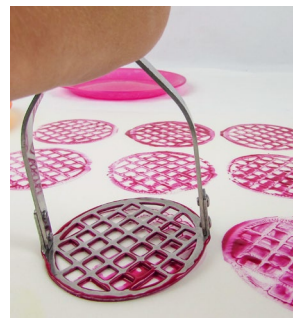


The supplies needed for Projects 41-44 are listed below.

Creative substitutions are welcome and exact sizes and quantities are somewhat flexible. These lists and photos are just to get you thinking about what you've already got and what you might want to gather for the upcoming activities.



TRACK PAINTING

- ❑ **Tempera Paint** (Optional: Thicken it with school glue.)
- ❑ **Heavy Paper or Large Sheets of Craft Foam, 12 x 18 or Larger** (Any paper will work, but thicker options like card stock or craft foam will buckle the least.)
- ❑ **Track Makers** (Toy cars, trucks, trains, tractors. You can even try full scale tricycles, big wheels, roller skates, and/or bikes!)

KINETIC SAND

- ❑ **Kinetic Sand** (We are officially recommending a DIY recipe, but of course, store bought kinetic sand can be used instead.)
Our DIY recipe calls for:
 - 1) Mixing Bowl and Spoon
 - 2) Liquid Laundry Detergent
 - 3) School Glue
 - 4) Food Coloring (for DIY color)
 - 5) Play Sand (2-5lbs, colored sand is available, if interested)
- ❑ **Sand Toys** (Assorted molds and shovels)
- ❑ **Tray**

PAPER TOWEL SHIBORI

- ❑ **Paper Towels** (We recommend Viva® paper towels for their cloth-like consistency.)
- ❑ **Watered-Down Tempera Paint** (Liquid watercolors, food coloring, or Rit® Liquid Dye can easily be substituted)
- ❑ **A Variety of Binding Tools** (Small binder clips or clothes pins, rubber bands, wooden blocks, craft string)
- ❑ **Containers for Water and Dye**
- ❑ **Tray**
- ❑ **Optional:** Rubber Gloves

KITCHEN UTENSILS

- ❑ **Tempera Paint** (Varied colors)
- ❑ **DIY Stamp Pads** (Sponges on plates)
- ❑ **Paper** (You can print on anything from thin newsprint to thick cardstock. Cardboard and fabric are options, too. If you try fabric, use acrylic paint instead of tempera so it won't wash off.)
- ❑ **A Variety of Kitchen Utensils** (Forks, potato mashers, spatulas, mixers, and anything else with unique printing potential from your kitchen!)
