

The supplies needed for Projects 45-48 are listed below.

Creative substitutions are welcome and exact sizes and quantities are somewhat flexible. These lists and photos are just to get you thinking about what you've already got and what you might want to gather for the upcoming activities.



PUFFY PAINTING

- Foam Shaving Cream**
- School Glue**
- Flour**
- Food Coloring**
- Heavy Paper** (any paper will work, but thicker options like card stock or even cardboard buckle the least.)
- Small Plastic Baggies**

PAPER PLAY

- Precut Strips of Construction Paper** (Size can vary, we used 1"x9" strips)
- School Glue or Glue Stick**
- Cardboard or Construction Paper Base** (Size is flexible, we used 12"x18")
- Hole Puncher** (Optional)

CRAFT FOAM STAMPING

- Craft Foam Shapes** (Use self-adhering pre-cut shapes or cut freeform pieces from larger craft foam sheets)
- Hot Glue** (Only needed if craft foam is not self-adhering)
- Stamp "Handles"** (We used corks, Jenga® pieces, and cardboard. Creative substitutions are welcome!)
- DIY Stamp Pads** (Sponges with tempera paint)
- Paper** (You can print on anything from thin newsprint to thick cardstock. Cardboard and fabric are options, too. If you try fabric, use acrylic paint instead of tempera so it won't wash off.)

WEAVING

- Cardboard**
- Scissors**
- Yarn**
- Miscellaneous Weaving Materials** (Feathers, pipe cleaners, ribbon, felt, twigs, heavy strips of paper...get creative!)
